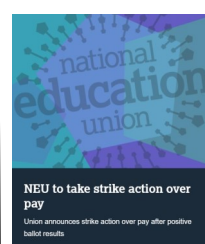
Yeadon Cricket Club are wanting new players of all abilities to join our Junior Section for the 2023 season.

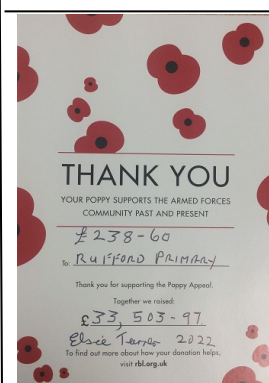
