If children are feeling lonely, need a friend to play with or need someone to talk then they can sit on the bench as a way of signalling to other children on the playground that they need support or need a friend. We agreed it was everyone's responsibility to look out for children sitting on the bench and we discussed how those children can be helped - by joining them on the bench for a chat, inviting them to play or finding some children they would like to play with."
