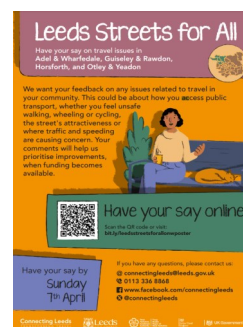


In assembly this week, Mrs Harris spoke to the children about how each one of us is a very special person. They talked about how we are all unique and the children shared qualities that make them special.
